# Pre-Master of Business Administration Course Assessment Format 



## 1. Grade

Students will be evaluated based on the sum of all points granted, and graded on a scale of A to D, and F; A (Excellent), B (Good), C (Satisfactory), D (Unsatisfactory pass) and F (Fail). The class distribution of the 5 grades will be based on a curve, relative to the total number of students who are eligible for grading. The standard grading curve is as follows: A (15\%), B (35\%), C (40\%) and D/F (10\%)*.
*Percentages differ depending on the course.

## 2. Grading Criteria

- Comprehension of the course concepts
- Overall contribution to the class discussions


## 3. Essentials modules (Essentials of Marketing and Strategy, Essentials of Accounting, Essentials of Finance)

Grades are finalized by taking into account the sum of all points granted for the following items.

## (1) Assignments

- Preparation Assignment 3 pts $\times 6$ classes + Class Review Post 1 pt $\times 5$ classes+ Review Assignment 9 pts $\times 1$ class $=32$ pts total
- Preparation Assignments are worth 3 points, Class Review Post are worth 1 point, and Review Assignments are worth 9 points upon submission and acceptance by the lecturer.
(2) Class discussions
- 6 classes $=48$ pts total
- Student participation will be assessed from both qualitative and quantitative perspectives, for the purpose of grading each student's contribution to the class.
- Quality E (Excellent): 5 pts, G (Good): 3 pts, None: 0 pt
- Quantity E (Excellent): 3 pts, G (Good): 2 pts, None: 0 pt


## 4. Other modules (Organizational Behavior and Leadership, Critical Thinking)

(1) Assignments

- Preparation Assignment 1 pt $\times 5$ classes + Class Review Post 1 pt $\times 5$ classes+ Review Assignment 3 pts $\times 1$ class $=13$ pts total
- Preparation Assignments are worth 1 point, Class Review Post are worth 1 point, and Review Assignments are worth 3 points upon submission and acceptance by the lecturer.
(2) Class discussions
- 6 classes $=48$ pts total
- Student participation will be assessed from both qualitative and quantitative perspectives, for the purpose of grading each student's contribution to the class.
- Quality E (Excellent): 5 pts, G (Good): 3 pts, None: 0 pt
- Quantity E (Excellent): 3 pts, G (Good): 2 pts, None: 0 pt
(3) Report 10 pts maximum $\times 4=40$ pts total
